



## Admission Report

April 6, 2020

### Enrollment

We currently have 496 students enrolled for the 2020-2021 school year, 420 returning students and 76 new students. This is well in excess of our budgeted enrollment of 476 students. **This number will change before opening day**, as we expect some attrition. Last year, between April and June we lost 15 students (an unusually large number), and it is possible this year we may have a comparable or even greater loss because of the uncertain economic times in light of the coronavirus pandemic. Nevertheless, we expect to open school at or above our budget of 476 students.

### Enrollment, by grade

We currently have five offers outstanding (one offer to a wait pool candidate in kindergarten, and four first-round offers for which we have given the families extensions (one for second grade, one for third grade, and two for fifth grade)).

### Demographics

Of the 496 students:

- 254 are boys (51.2%), 238 are girls (48.0%), and 4 are non-binary (0.8%)
- 127 students are receiving sliding scale tuition (25.6%); of that group, 17 are faculty/staff children who are also receiving tuition remission. Two additional faculty/staff children are receiving tuition remission but not sliding scale tuition.

- **School-wide, 50% are students of color** – this is the first time in the school's history we have reached this milestone number school-wide!
- Students of color comprise 55.6% of preschool enrollment for the fall.

### **Attrition**

Attrition thus far for the upcoming school year is very low at 1.9% school-wide. To date, we have a total of 9 students not returning for 2020-2021, including 1 who left mid-year, broken down as follows:

- 7 will be moving (1 mid-year)
- 1 will be attending public school
- 1 will be attending another independent school
